15th Annual Marsha Martin Scholarship Program Guidelines



Texas Farm Credit Services established an agricultural scholarship program in honor of Marsha Pyle Martin, a Paris, Texas native, who served as chairman and Chief Executive Officer of the

Farm Credit Administration (FCA), an independent federal agency responsible for regulation and examination of the Farm Credit System - a network of farmer-owned cooperative financial institutions, until her death from cancer in January 2000. Martin, appointed to a six-year term by President Clinton in 1994, was the first woman to serve as chairman in the 65-year history of the FCA. Martin was also the first woman senior executive in the Farm Credit System, serving as vice president of the Farm Credit Bank of Texas and the first woman to serve as director of the Farm Credit System Insurance Corporation. A lifelong advocate for farmers, ranchers, and rural America, Martin spent more than 30 years working in agriculture and agricultural finance. Each year, Texas Farm Credit is pleased to continue her legacy by offering postsecondary scholarships in Martin's name to future agricultural leaders. Texas Farm Credit awards five, one-time scholarships in the amount of \$2,000.

TO QUALIFY FOR TEXAS FARM CREDIT'S MARSHA MARTIN SCHOLARSHIP, ALL APPLICANTS:

- 1. Must pursue an *agricultural related degree* (agricultural business, animal science, agricultural economics, etc.).
- 2. Reside inside of Texas Farm Credit's 100-County Territory (see map).
- 3. Be nominated by a school guidance counselor, teacher, or administrator.
- 4. Be a senior scheduled to graduate high school in 2015.
- 5. Be accepted to a junior college, community college, or four-year university.
- 6. Submit a completed scholarship application.
- 7. Submit an official high school transcript.
- 8. Submit a one-page essay on "How I plan to contribute to the mission Marsha Martin supported".
